
The Process To Become CCC Member

2 Upon receipt of all documents by the end of the two-month observer period, the CCC Executive Committee reviews and recommends the applicant for membership voting, providing they meet the criteria in the CCC Charter.

After 10 days, ballots will be distributed to the general membership for voting. A 50 percent plus-one majority vote from the CCC membership is required to formally accept all new members into CCC.

5 CCC will formally announce acceptance as a CCC member. Payment of full membership fees will be required from the day of acceptance.



Organizations wishing to become FULL MEMBERS or ASSOCIATE MEMBERS of CCC must first establish themselves as OBSERVERS for a period of two months.

Upon receipt of the membership application, CCC informs the general membership that the application has been lodged.

The applicant has up to two months to provide the required documents to CCC. As an observer the applicant is entitled to participate in CCC meetings and other activities but not to vote at meetings.

A representative of the applicant organization is required to make a short presentation about their organization and its program in Cambodia at the CCC Bi-monthly Members' Meeting.

There is a 10-day period in which members can raise serious objections to the application. The CCC Executive Committee may require up to three letters of reference in support of the application in the case of objections.
